- Developing issues, such as the prospect of a UK state aid regime

Partner and competition litigation expert, Anna Morfey, joins the morning panel to offer insight into 'litigating financial services claims', alongside Charlie Morris of Woodsford Litigation Funding and Angela Taylor of Travers Smith. They will offer views from claimant and defendant perspectives, and update practitioners on the progress of a variety of financial services related claims, both in the High Court and EU jurisdictions.

The day concludes with a drinks reception, providing the opportunity to network with like-minded individuals from business, public sector and private practice firms.
